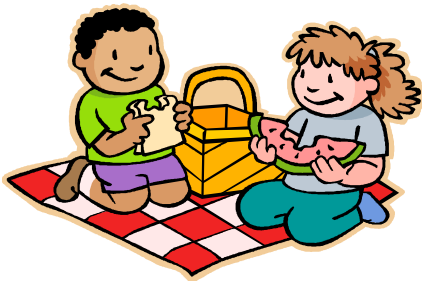

## **BROADWAY CAMPUS RELOCATION**

Audubon Charter School's Broadway Campus is scheduled for renovation as a part of the Master Plan, which was approved by the Orleans Parish School Board (OPSB) and the Board of Elementary & Secondary Education (BESE) in 2008. This renovation will require that the campus be relocated to a temporary site (referred to as "Swing Space") for 24 months. The campus will be moving in December (exact dates TBD) and operate at the site of the former Jean Gordon Elementary School 6101 Chatham Dr., New Orleans, LA 70122.

### **AUDUBON RECEIVES NEW GRANTS!!!!**

Audubon Charter has received several grants to fund various school programs and needs. The **RosaMary Foundation** is funding the development of a school-wide Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) model. The grant will pay for a new staff member to develop and implement a school wide preventive approach to discipline over a two-year period. The student service coordinator will be responsible for PBIS, Response to Intervention (RTI) and other student services. We have also received a **Louisiana Renaissance Language Immersion Program** grant that will support a new full-time French interventionist position. The French interventionist will work with struggling students, and provide teachers with research-based strategies that will positively impact instruction for all students in the French program. Audubon Charter has also received an unrestricted two-year grant from the **Keller Foundation**, an **Entergy Charitable Foundation** grant for Pre-K, and funding from the **Selley Foundation** that will pay for a portion of each child's participation in T.R.E.E. field trips this year. We are most grateful to these funders for their generous support and commitment to Audubon.

### **PTO, FAME and ADMINISTRATION**

- The Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) is called the Friends of Audubon PTO. It is a non-profit organization that includes **ALL** parents and teachers of Audubon Charter School (ACS).
- ACS operates under the governance of the Board of French and Montessori Education, Inc. or FAME, Inc.
- The school administration runs the day-to-day operations of the school in accordance with the school's charter.

*All three of these entities work in tandem on certain issues to ensure the optimal success of our school.*

Each year, Audubon Charter School requests Annual Fund gifts to help bridge the "gap" between what it costs to educate our students and the revenue that Audubon receives from the State. This year's gap is \$73,611, or approximately \$92 per child. State and local funds do not fully cover the school's essential expenses, including additional teacher and teaching assistant salaries. Therefore, the school must look to families, staff, and faculty to help cover the additional costs of our advanced Montessori and French curricula. The school's goal is 100% family participation. We welcome gifts of any amount and ask that families give as generously as they can.
