Changes in the Meal Application for 2009-10

- The new name for Food Stamp Program - SNAP* – Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program. Whenever the SNAP number is requested, enter the Food Stamp Number
- If your child(children) are Homeless, Migrant or a Runaway, check the box in Part 2 of the application
- Total Household Gross Income – Part 4 – If you have Zero (0) income, check the box at the end of line “Check if NO income”
- Part VI. Children’s Racial and Ethnic identities (optional) – Choose one or more, if Hispanic or Latino please choose one in the last column

POLICY REMINDERS

Prepayment of Student Meals

Parents may pay for meals in advance by using the following acceptable methods: money order or cash. An online payment option is forthcoming. Receipts will be issued upon request.

One Day Charge

Students can charge a meal for one day when he/she does not have money for the price of the meal. Students must clear this balance before they are eligible to charge again.
