Please send the following items unlabeled. (They are to be used jointly.) We will label notebooks/composition books for each child.

- 6 - black & white marble 100 sheet marble-no color of fancy covers composition books
(Note Rite Aid usually has a 3 for \$1.00 sale in the summer. You may want to look out for this ad during the summer and stock up.)
- 4 - pocket folders with brads and pockets of the following colors: (orange, blue, red, yellow)
- 4 - glue sticks
- 4 - Scotch tape
- 1 - Fiskar school scissors
- 24 - #2 pencils (sharpened if possible) no mechanical or special designed pencils
- 1 - pack of colored pencils
- 2 - large pink erasers
- 2 - red pens
- 1 - pack of thick washable markers
- 1 - watercolor paint set (boxes only)
- 2 - rolls of paper towels
- 2 - boxes of Kleenex
- 1 - package of yellow Swiffers for dusting (not the floor kind) refills okay
- 1 - 409 spray
- 1 - quart size Ziploc bags with slides (boys)
- 1 - gallon size Ziploc style bags with slides (girls)
- 1 - package multicolor construction paper
- 1 - pencil sharpener (the hand held kind for individual use)

The class needs an electric pencil sharpener. If anyone would like to donate one, please do. Each year I have had to purchase a new one. They tend to break because of the amount of use in the classroom.

Some items may need to be replaced during the year. A note will be sent home; (should we begin to run out of these items), asking for replacements.
