



## Ms. Jennifer's Fourth and Fifth Grade Class Supply List 2009-2010 School Year

- 2 - folders with pockets (communication folders) -
- 1- marble composition notebook (journal)
- 2 packs (10 count) of blue or black erasable pens (Regular ink may be used, but mistakes can create messy notes/work.)
- 1 inch binder and dividers
- 2 small packs (3-5 count) of red ink pens
- Expos markers- community property (We will use this for math.)
- clip board
- 1 set of 24 colored pencils (please include pink, lavender and light blue)
- 1 set of 8-12 markers
- 1 pack of crayons (optional)
- 2 small packs (2-3 count) of black Sharpie markers (thin tip)
- hand-held sharpener (preferably the ones with the attached "cup" to catch shavings)
- 4 packs (24 per pack) #2 pencils - community
- 6 packs of notebook paper- community
- 1 pack of loose leaf hole reinforcers (500 count)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 rolls of tape w/ dispenser ( the plastic type )
- 12 glue sticks
- 4 orange, pink, green or blue highlighters (some of the yellow ones are difficult to read)
- a large sturdy pencil box or container with a lid (preferably one that closes securely)
- 2 wooden or **rigid** plastic rulers
- a protractor
- 4 packs (100 count) of lined (ruled) index cards - preferably 4x6 sized but 3/5 may be used (We're going to use these to create a personalized vocabulary reference file. We are also going to use index cards to take notes and make flash cards.)
- plastic index card file box (alphabetical index tabs for index card file box- optional - but would be very helpful for your child)
- 1 bottle of tempura paint- your color choice
- 2 bottles of hand sanitizer
- 4 boxes of tissue (Kleenex) - young ladies only
- 2 rolls of paper towels - young gentlemen only
- 2 containers of bleach-free disinfecting wipes - young ladies only
- 4 boxes of dusters (Swiffers) - young gentlemen only
